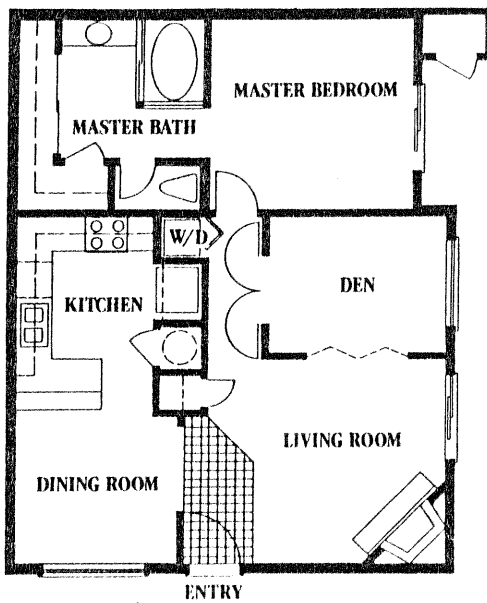


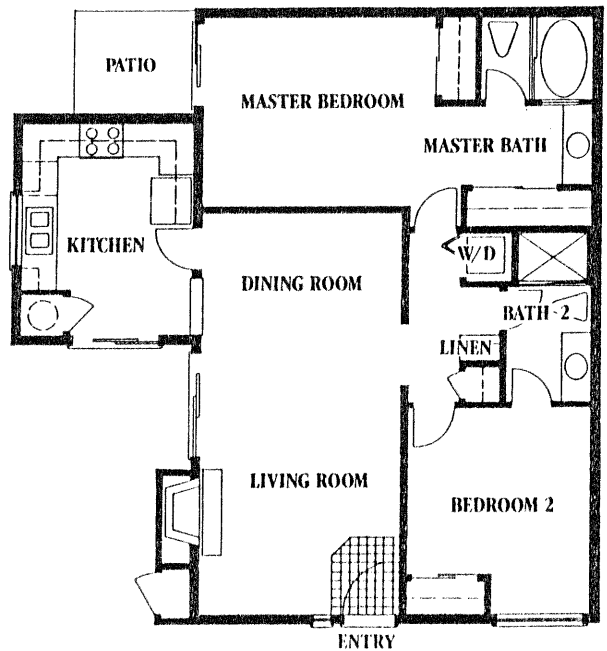
**Plan 1

The three-masted Balclutha has enjoyed a close association with San Francisco Bay for nearly 100 years. She made the Cape Horn voyage from Bay Area ports to Europe regularly during the 1880's and 1890's, and later took part in the trans-Pacific lumber trade making Redwood City one of her ports of call. The Balclutha has since been restored and is docked at Pier 43 in San Francisco.

This four-masted bark made the long Cape Horn voyage to Europe from several Bay Area ports regularly around the turn of the century. She took part in the enormous grain trade of the time.
